

Learn more about the Scholarshipped program

- The program is only open to underprivileged girls from Zambia
- Girls between the ages of 11-18 are eligible to apply
- Applications are open once a year to applicants

Our main goal is to identify three brilliant girls between the ages of 11-18 that we can award three full educational scholarships and to later integrate the girls into our mentorship programs. To be considered, the girls would have to apply using a scholarship application form, providing us their details and complete essay of their educational goals. Once we have managed to identify our girls, we plan to continue to provide ongoing support until the completion of their education.

Specifications

Girls selected for our scholarship program will be chosen based on several factors that are included in our application forms. These factors will include;

- Personal conditions/limitation: Orphan, unemployed parents/guardians, difficulties at home, first to go to school
- Number of people in a household
- Performance in school
- Involvement in extra circular activities e.g sports, art, etc
- Complete essay describing their educational goals

Once girls are selected, they will be introduced and integrated into our mentorship programs;

- Etiquette her- teaches her proper etiquette, from table manners to public presence
- Sister's keeper- counseling girls that may be dealing with complicated personal issues
- Girl talk 101- Monthly talk sessions that allow for interaction and participation from girls on several topics.
